We are excited to share that on Thursday 9th March 2023 Rowling Class will be visiting Yorkshire Wildlife Park. The trip will take place during the normal school day but please ensure your child arrives at school promptly. We will be leaving the academy at 9:00 and returning for 15:30. During the trip we will be able to explore the park, learning about the different animals and habitats in which they live. This visit links closely with our 'All Creatures Great and Small' topic and will help us to enhance our learning of habitats, food chains and classification.



Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle in a rucksack style bag which they will carry around the park. Children can wear non-uniform appropriate for the weather including comfortable footwear and a waterproof coat.

Children can bring a maximum of £10 spending money which they can use in the park gift shop. Please note that children will be responsible for carrying their own money.
